


Figure 2. Uvalde field trip, February 1991




Figure 7. Soil Texture Contest, 1991: Dennis Brezina




Figure 8. Soil Texture Contest - 1991: Lynn Loomis (co-winner); John Jacob (contest administrator); and Conrad Neitsch (co-winner).




Figure 9. Field Trip to Barton Creek Properties, Austin, January 1993: Dr. Larry Wilding (left, blue cap) and Dr. Chock Woodruff (top, red vest and bucket hat), one of field trip leaders.




Figure 11. 1994 field trip, near Graham - Conrad Neitsch (closest to camera)




Figure 12. Dinner at 1994 Meeting, Graham (clockwise, left to right) - Fred Schrank; unidentified person; Jamey Douglas; Levi Steptoe; and Kirby Griffith.




Figure 14. 1995 field trip - Windthorst pit, James Greenwade.




Figure 18. NRCS booth at CAST (Conference for the Advancement of Science Teaching), November 2001, Austin: Maurice Jurena and Stacey Kloesel. (PSSAT also represented at booth)




Figure 19. 2002 Meeting (foreground, left to right): Dr. Clyde Stahnke; Charlie Thompson; and Alan Stahnke. Members in background: Michael Golden; James Greenwade; Jerry Rives; Kirby Griffith; Sam Brown; and Tom Cyprian.
